The DanPaul Foundation was established by Mary E. "Libby" Cornett in memory of her sons, Dan and Paul, and her husband, and their father, Mike Cornett, who all drowned when their sailboat, *Morning Dew*, foundered off the coast of Charleston, South Carolina, in December 29, 1997.

In the future, after a few years of experience, the Foundation plans to use its resources to train teachers in early childhood development, protect children from abuse, stimulate their personal responsibility, and offer them opportunities for enrichment. The Foundation will also encourage children to be concerned about the environment and the underprivileged, particularly with regard to clean air and water, housing and nutrition.

The Foundation hopes to implement programs, or contribute funds to existing, Section 501(c)(3) organization, programs, in the following areas:

| Education: | Early childhood development and reading, seminars for training teacher and parents, scholarships for teachers and student to learn more about early childhood development |
| Children's Rights: | Protection from abuse, quality after-school care, camps for at-risk children (truants and children with behavioral issues), learning camps which focus on new experiences in areas such as computers, physics, and chemistry |
| Environment: | Environmental children's camps focusing on ecology, school programs, responsibility programs |
| Underprivileged: | Group and low-cost housing, food for the needy, clean water |

Initially, the Foundation will contribute its funds to existing, Section 501(c)(3) organizations that have programs which closely mirror the above programs. Once the Foundation has been established for a few years and the officers and directors have more experience on operating a charitable organization, the intent is to qualify the Foundation as either a private operating foundation or a public charity. However, currently, the Foundation is only applying for private foundation status.

- 2 What are or will be the organization's sources of financial support? List in order of size.

A one-time contribution of a \$1,550,000.00 was donated to the Foundation to be used in connection with its charitable purpose. The Foundation will use a substantial portion of the income from this endowment to fund its projects.
